The opening of the first school



Soon after beginning their actions to help the children, Christian and Marie-France des Pallières, the founders of PSE, decided to set up a school because education helps children escape poverty.

They bought land to build a school, but they faced a really big and unexpected problem: there was no water to be found! The workers dug and dug, and there was none. Finally, the day before the start of the new school year, they reached 120 feet (40 metres) below ground level and found water! Imagine the relief Christian and Marie-France felt when they realised they

could welcome the first 250 children - in good conditions. What an adventure for this first school year!



The name of the little girl on our logo is Chenda. Christian and Marie-France met Chenda 25 years ago at the dumpsite. They liked her smile so much PSE, she is a salesperson and has even become a mother!

The buildings you see in the photo are of the boarding school. Children who attend school at PSE but live too far away can live at the school. Others live there because they are not safe at home. Their parents have great difficulty raising them in the right environment, so PSE hosts them to make sure they are safe and can grow up in a peaceful environment.



Questions & answers

What is an association?

An association is when at least two people choose to come together to develop a common project. Anyone is able to set up an association, it is even enshrined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights!



There are associations in almost all areas: culture, sport, art, the environment and to defend the rights of children, women and men.

An association is necessarily a "non-profit" which means that the objective of those who create it is not to keep money they earn for themselves. It works with the help of volunteers who give their time for free to allow their project to develop. PSE has more than 300 volunteers.
